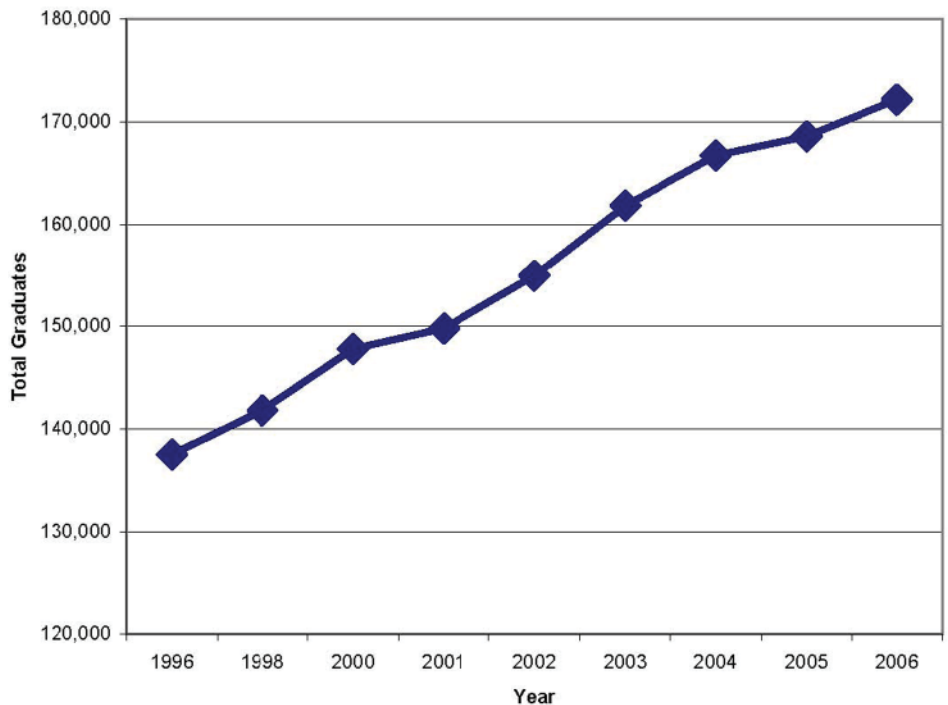

Catholic Higher Education Degree Completion Rates: 1996-2006

From 1996 to 2006, the number of students earning degrees at Catholic colleges and universities grew by more than 34,000. While less than 140,000 students earned degrees at any academic level from Catholic colleges and universities in 1996, that figure rose to more than 172,000 students by 2006; this is a 25% increase over 10 years.
